## Cellphone Policy & Agreement

At Blackville School, we are committed to maintaining a safe and focused learning environment. While we recognize that cellphones are an important part of everyday life, their use during instructional time can be distracting and disruptive. Students are expected to follow the guidelines below.

### Usage Expectations

#### Middle School Students (Grades 6–8):

- Phones may only be used before and after school hours.
- They must remain off and stored away during the school day.

#### High School Students (Grades 9–12):

- Phones may be used during break and lunch.
- They must remain off and away during instructional time unless permitted by a teacher.

### Consequences for Non-Compliance

<b>First Offence</b>	Student gives phone to teacher. Teacher contacts home. Student picks up phone at end of day from office.
<b>Second Offence</b>	Student gives phone to teacher. Teacher contacts home. Parent/guardian must come to school to pick up the phone.
<b>Third Offence</b>	Student receives a 1-day suspension. Parent/guardian notified.
<b>Fourth Offence</b>	For 1 week, student leaves phone in the office each morning and picks it up at the end of the day.
<b>Fifth Offence</b>	For 1 school term, student leaves phone in the office each morning and picks it up at the end of the day.
