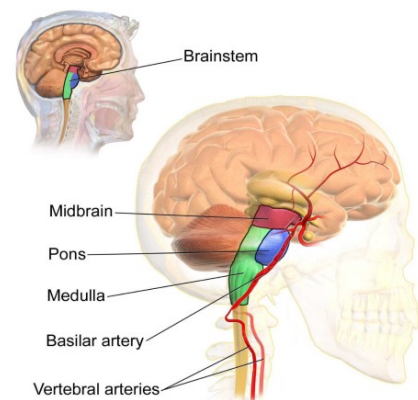


Brain Stem

- The brainstem is the inner part of the brain that connect the brain to the spinal cord. It is made up of: midbrain, pons, and medulla oblong ata.
- The brainstem regulate breathing, heart rate, blood pressure, consciousness, audio-visual reflexes, taste and digestion, autonomic regulation, balance and coordination



Cerebellum

- It generates and regulate the impulses to maintain muscle tone, balance and posture.
